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# CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY

Purpose: To protect consumers by ensuring only qualified licensees practice public accountancy in accordance with established professional standards.

Authority: Business and Professions Code § 5000 et seq.

Appointing Power: Governor – 11  
Senate Rules Committee – 2  
Speaker of the Assembly – 2

Number: Fifteen (15)

Special Considerations: No public member shall be a current or former licensee of the board or an immediate family member of a licensee, or be currently or formerly employed by a public accounting firm, bookkeeping firm, or firm engaged in providing tax preparation as its primary business, or have any financial interest in the business of a licensee. Each public member shall meet all of the requirements for public membership on the board as set forth in Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 450) of Division 1. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5000.5.)

Each member of the board, except the public members, shall be actively engaged in the practice of public accountancy and shall have been so engaged for a period of no less than five (5) years preceding the date of his appointment. Each member shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of this state for at least five (5) years next preceding his appointment, and shall be of good character. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5001.)

Additional statutory requirements for public members shall be as follows under Bus. & Prof. Code §§ 450 et seq.

Qualifications: Governor: (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5000.)  
1) Four (4) public members;  
2) Seven (7) licensed members.

When appointing licensed members, the Governor shall appoint members representing a cross section of the accounting profession.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5000.)

One (1) licensee member appointed by the Governor may be an active educator within a program that emphasizes the study of accounting within a college, university, or four (4)-year educational institution. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5001(b).)

- Term:                      Four (4) years. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term of a person licensed in the same capacity as the person being replaced. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5002.)
- Term Limits:              Cannot serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5002.)
- Grace Period:              Members shall hold office until the appointment of a successor or until one (1) year shall have elapsed since the expiration of the term for which he or she was appointed, whichever first occurs.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code, § 5002.)
- Compensation:              One hundred dollars (\$100) for each day spent on official duties and traveling and other related expenses (Bus. & Prof. Code § 103.)
- Meeting Frequency:              Shall meet at the call of the president and executive officer, but not less than twice a year. Any two (2) members of the board may request the executive office to call a special meeting, and the executive officer, upon receiving that notice, shall call a meeting pursuant to the procedure prescribed herein.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code, § 5016.)
- Bond:                              Not stated in statute.
- Oath:                              Within thirty (30) days after their appointment, the members of the board shall take and subscribe to the oath of office as prescribed by the Government Code and shall file the same with the Secretary of State. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5001.)
- Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.
- Duties:                              The board shall compile and maintain, or may have compiled and maintained of its behalf, a register of licensees that contains information that the board determines is necessary for the purposes for which the board was established. The board shall make the register available to any licensee and to the public.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5009.)
- The board shall keep records of all proceedings and actions by and before the board and before its committees. In and proceeding in

court, civil, or criminal, copies of those records certified as correct be the executive officer of the board under seal of the board shall be admissible in evidence and shall be prima facie evidence of the correctness of the contents thereof. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5013.)

In exercising its power under this section for the interests of consumer protection, the board shall establish standards which will assure reasonable currency of knowledge as a basis for a high standard of practice by licensee. The standards shall be established in a manner to assure that a variety of alternatives are available to licensees to comply with the continuing education requirements for renewal of licenses and taking cognizance of specialized areas of practice. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5027.)

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the board may inquire into any alleged violation of this chapter or any other state or federal law, regulation, or rule relevant to the practice of accountancy. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5103(a).)

The members of the board may hold executive sessions to prepare, approve, grade, or administer examinations and shall have jurisdictions or vote over these functions of preparing, approving, grading, or administering examinations in executive session as provided for in Section 11126 of the Government Code. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5017.)

- Appointing Power: Governor - 2  
Teachers' Retirement Board - 1  
Board of Administration of the Public Employees' Retirement System - 1  
State Association of County Retirement Systems - 1  
Board of Regents of the University of California - 1  
Speaker of the Assembly - 1  
Senate Committee on Rules - 1
- Number: Eight (8)
- Special Consideration:
- Qualifications: Each member shall be an actuary, as defined in Section 7507, with public sector clients. (Gov. Code § 7507.2(c).)  
1) "Actuary" means an actuary who is an associate or fellow of the Society of Actuaries. (Gov. Code § 7507(a)(1).)
- Term: Three (3) years. (Gov. Code § 7507.2(c).)
- Term Limits: No statutory requirement.
- Grace Period: Shall continue to serve until a successor has been qualified. (Gov. Code § 1302.)
- Compensation: None, actual and necessary expenses that shall be paid by the authority that appointed the member. (Gov. Code § 7507.2(f).)
- Meeting Frequency: Meet quarterly. (Gov. Code § 7507.2(a).)
- Bond: No statutory requirement.
- Oath: Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.
- Duties: Responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to: (Gov. Code § 7507.2(b)(1-6).)  
1) Defining the range of actuarial model policies and best practices for public retirement plan benefits, including pensions and other postemployment benefits;

- 2) Developing pricing and disclosure standards for California public section benefit improvements;
- 3) Developing quality control standards for California public sector actuaries;

## ACUPUNCTURE BOARD

- Purpose: Benefit, educate and protect the public through regulation of licensure; development of education standards; provisions of consumer information; and enforcement for the Acupuncture Licensure Act.
- Authority: Business and Professions Code §§ 4928 et seq.
- Appointing Power: Governor – 5 (requires Senate confirmation)  
Speaker of the Assembly – 1  
Senate Rules Committee – 1
- Number: Seven (7)
- Special Considerations: The acupuncturist shall be appointed to represent a cross section of the cultural backgrounds of licensed members of the acupuncturist profession and must have least five (5) years experience in acupuncture. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 4929.)
- The public members shall not hold a license or certificate as a physician and surgeon or acupuncturist.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 4929.)
- Qualifications: Governor appoints three (3) acupuncturist members and two (2) public members. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 4929.)
- Senate Rules Committee and the Speaker of the Assembly each appoints one (1) public member. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 4929.)
- Term: Four (4) years (Bus. & Prof. Code § 4930.)
- Term Limits: Cannot serve for more than two (2) consecutive full terms.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 131.)
- Grace Period: Sixty (60) days (Gov. Code § 1774.)
- Compensation: One hundred dollars (\$100) for each day actually spent on official duties, and traveling and other expenses necessarily incurred.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 103.)
- Meeting Frequency: Full board shall meet at least three (3) times each calendar year, once each year in northern California and at least once each year in southern California in order to facilitate participation by the public and its licensees.  
(Board Procedure Manual Ch. 2; Bus. & Prof. Code § 101.7(a).)

Bond: No statutory requirement.

Oath: Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.

Duties: The board may adopt, amend, or repeal, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (Chapter 3.5 (commencing with Section 11340) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code), regulations as may be necessary to enable it to carry into effect the provisions of law relating to the practice of acupuncture. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 4933(a).)

The board may deny, suspend, revoke, or impose probationary conditions upon the license of any acupuncturist if he or she is guilty of committing a fraudulent act, as specified. (Bus. & Prof. Code §§ 4955.1, 4955.2)

**CALIFORNIA COUNCIL FOR  
INTERSTATE ADULT OFFENDER SUPERVISION**

Purpose: To provide the framework for the promotion of public safety and protect the rights of victims through the control and regulation of the interstate movement of offenders in the community. Additionally, provide for the effective tracking, supervision, and rehabilitation of these offenders by the sending and receiving states.  
(Pen. Code § 11180 (Art. I).)

Authority: Penal Code §§ 11180 et seq.

Appointing Power: Governor – 3  
Senate Committee on Rules – 1  
Speaker of the Assembly – 1  
Judicial Council – 1

Number: Seven (7)

Special Considerations: While each member state may determine the membership of its own state council, its membership must include at least one (1) representative from the legislative, judicial, and executive branches of government, victims groups and compact administrators. Each compacting state retains the right to determine the qualifications of the Compact Administrator who shall be appointed by the state council or by the Governor in consultation with the Legislature and the Judiciary. (Pen. Code § 11180(Art. IV).)

Qualifications: Governor appoints three (3) members (Pen. Code § 11181(c).)

- 1) One (1) public member,
- 2) One (1) shall represent victims' rights groups;
- 3) One (1) shall represent chief probation officers.

Senate Committee on Rules appoints one (1) member; No qualifications stated in governing statute. (Pen. Code § 11181(c).)

Speaker of the Assembly appoints one (1) member; No qualifications stated in governing statute. (Pen. Code § 11181(c).)

Judicial Council appoints one (1) superior court judge.  
(Pen. Code § 11181(c).)

The Director of Corrections, or his or her designee, shall be a member and serve as the Commissioner, who shall represent California and serve on the Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision. The Commissioner shall also be the Compact Administrator for the State of California for purposes of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision.  
(Pen. Code § 11181(c).)

- Term: Four (4) years from the date of appointment, with the exception of the commissioner. (Pen. Code § 11181(d).)
- Term Limits: Not stated in statute.
- Grace Period: Shall continue to serve until a successor has been qualified. (Gov. Code § 1302.)
- Compensation: Council members shall not be compensated, except for reasonable per diem expenses related to their work for council purposes. (Pen. Code § 11181(d).)
- Meeting Frequency: Shall meet at least once (1) during each calendar year. The Chair may call additional meetings at any time and, upon the request of a majority of the members, shall call additional meetings. (Pen. Code § 11180(Art. III).)
- Bond: Not stated in statute.
- Oath: Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.
- Duties: Shall exercise oversight and advocacy concerning its participation in Interstate Commission activities, and other duties as may be determined by the Legislature or Governor, including but not limited to, development of policy concerning operations and procedures of the compact within the state. (Pen. Code § 11181(b).)

Qualifications: Governor appoints seven (7) members, at least four (4) of whom shall reside within the boundaries of the 6<sup>th</sup> Agricultural District. (Food and Agr. Code § 4104(c).)

The Senator representing the Senate district in which the California African American Museum is located and the Assembly Member representing the Assembly district in which the museum is located shall be ex officio nonvoting members.

- The two (2) legislative ex officio nonvoting members of the board shall participate in the activities of the board to the extent that their participation is not incompatible with their respective positions as Members of the Legislature. (Food & Agr. Code § 4104(c).)

Term: Four (4) years. (Food & Agr. Code § 4104(c).)

Term Limits: Not stated in statute.

Grace Period: Continues to serve until replacement has been qualified. (Gov. Code § 1302.)

Compensation: None; only actual and necessary expenses. (Board Bylaws(D).)

Meeting Frequency: Not stated in statute.

Bond: Not stated in statute.

Oath: Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.

Duties: Shall preserve, collect and display samples of African-American contributions to the arts, science, religion, education, literature, entertainment, politics, sports, and history of the state and nation.

## CALIFORNIA COMMISSION ON AGING

Purpose: Serve as the principal advocate body in the state on behalf of older individuals, including, but not limited to, advisory participation in the consideration of all legislation and regulations made by state and federal departments and agencies relating to programs and services that affect older individuals.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9202(a).)

Authority: Welfare and Institutions Code § 9200 et seq.

Appointing Power: Governor – 19  
Speaker of Assembly – 3  
Senate Rules Committee – 3

Number: Twenty-five (25)

Special Considerations: The commission shall be comprised of:  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9200(a)(3-5).)

- A majority of members sixty (60) years of age or older;
- Actual consumers of services under federal Older Americans Act (42 U.S.C. § 3001, et seq.), as amended;
- The commission shall be composed of representatives of the geographic, cultural, economic, and other social factors of the state.

Qualifications: Governor appoints nineteen (19) members.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9200(a)(2)(A).)

- Nine (9) shall be appointed from lists of nominees submitted by the area agency on aging advisory councils. At least five (5) names shall be submitted as nominees for each vacancy.
- Ten (10) public members

Senate Committee on Rules appoints three (3) members.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9200(a)(2)(B-C).)

Speaker of the Assembly appoints three (3) members.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9200(a)(2)(B-C).)

Term: Terms begin from the effective date of appointment and shall last three (3) years; staggered. (Welf. and Inst. Code § 9201.)

The commission composition requirements shall be complied with as vacancies occur. (Welf. and Inst. Code § 9200(b).)

Term Limits: Members shall not serve more than two (2) terms.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9201.)

- Actively participate and advise the department in the development and preparation of the State plan on Aging, conduct public hearings on the State Plan on Aging, review and comment on the State Plan on Aging, review and comment on the State Plan, and monitor the progress of the plan's implementation.  
(Welf. and Inst. Code § 9202(d).)
- Hold hearings throughout the state, that may include conducting an annual statewide hearing inviting all departments administering programs affecting seniors, in order to gather information and advise the Governor, Legislature, department, and agencies on all levels of government regarding solutions to problems confronting older individuals and the most effective use of existing resources and available services for individuals.

Purpose: Hold fairs, expositions, and exhibitions for the purpose of exhibiting all of the industries and industrial enterprises, resources and products of every kind of nature of the state with a view toward improving, exploiting, encouraging, and stimulating them.  
(Food & Agr. Code § 3951(a).)

Construct, maintain, and operate recreational and cultural facilities of general public interest. (Food & Agr. Code § 3951(b).)

Authority: Food and Agriculture § 3951 et seq.

Appointing Power: Governor

Number: Nine (9)

Special Considerations:

Qualifications: Shall be citizens and residents of the district.  
(Food & Agr. Code § 3956.)

If two (2) or more counties constitute a district, each county shall be represented on the board by at least two (2) persons who are citizens and residents of such county. (Food & Agr. Code § 3957.)

Term: Four (4) years, from the beginning of the term for which he/she is appointed. (Food & Agr. Code § 3960.)

Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.  
(Food & Agr. Code § 3960.)

If, by reason of the formation of a new district, a director in one (1) district becomes a resident of another district, his term of office as director expires sixty (60) days after the formation of the new district. (Food & Agr. Code § 3958.)

Term Limits: Not stated in statute.

Grace Period: Shall continue to serve until a successor has been qualified.  
(Gov. Code. § 1302.)

Compensation: None, only actual and necessary expenses.

Meeting Frequency: Shall meet at a place within the district.  
(Food & Agr. Code § 3963.)

- 3) Make all necessary bylaws, rules, and regulations for the government of the association;
- 4) With the approval of the Department of General Services, arrange for and conduct, or cause to be conducted, or by contract permit to be conducted, by any other individual, institution, corporation, or association, upon its property at such times as it may deem advisable, any activity, notwithstanding any other provisions of the code.

- Purpose: Provide policy advice on apprenticeship matters to the Director of Industrial Relations, issuing rules and regulations on specific apprenticeship subjects to be published in the California Code of Regulations, and conducting appeals hearings.
- Authority: Labor Code § 3070.
- Appointing Power: Governor - 14
- Number: Seventeen (17)
- Special Considerations:
- Qualifications: Governor appoints fourteen (14) representatives:  
(Lab. Code § 3070.)
- 1) Six (6) representatives from employers or employer organizations;
  - 2) Six (6) representatives from employee organizations that sponsor apprenticeship programs under this chapter, respectively, geographically selected;
  - 3) Two (2) representatives of the general public.
- Director of Industrial Relations, or his or her permanent and best qualified designee. (Lab. Code § 3070.)
- Superintendent of Public Instruction, or his or her permanent and best qualified designee. (Lab. Code § 3070.)
- Chancellor of the California Community Colleges, or his or her permanent and best qualified designee. (Lab. Code § 3070.)
- Term: Four (4) years. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term of his or her predecessor shall be appointed for the remainder of that term. (Lab. Code § 3070.)
- Term Limits: Not stated in statute.
- Grace Period: Continues to serve until replacement has qualified.  
(Gov. Code, § 1302.)
- Compensation: One hundred dollars (\$100) for each day of actual attendance at meetings and hearings by the council or a committee, approved by the Director of Industrial Relations, thereof pursuant to Lab. Code § 3082, and shall be reimbursed actual and necessary traveling expenses. (Lab. Code § 3070.)

Meeting

Frequency:

Shall meet quarterly at a designated date and special meetings may be held at the call of the Chair. Council shall meet at the call of the Director of Industrial Relations and shall aid him or her in formulating policies for the effective administration of this chapter. (Lab. Code § 3071.)

Bond:

Not stated in statute.

Oath:

Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.

Duties:

Shall issue rules and regulations which establish standards for minimum wages, maximum hours, and working conditions for apprenticeship standards, which in no case shall be lower than those prescribed by this chapter; (Lab. Code § 3071.)

Shall issue rules and regulations governing equal opportunities in apprenticeship, affirmative action programs which include women and minorities in apprenticeship, and other on-the-job training, and criteria for selection procedures with a view particularly toward eliminating criteria not relevant to qualification for training employment or more stringent than is reasonably necessary. (Lab. Code § 3071.)

## CALIFORNIA ARCHITECTS BOARD

- Purpose: Regulate the practice of architecture in the interest and for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare. The board shall delineate the minimum professional qualifications and performance standards for admission to and practice of the profession of architecture. Lastly, the board shall establish a fair and uniform enforcement policy to deter and prosecute violations of consumers.
- Authority: Business and Professions Code §§ 5510 et seq.
- Appointing Power: Governor – 8  
Senate Rules Committee – 1  
Speaker of the Assembly – 1
- Number: Ten (10)
- Special Considerations:
- Qualifications: Governor: Three (3) public members and five (5) licensed members (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)
- The five (5) professional members of the board shall be selected from architects in good standings who have been licensed and in practice in this state for at least five (5) years at the time of appointment, all of whom shall be residents and in practice in California. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5514.)
- The public members of the board shall not be licensees of the board. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5514.)
- Public Members cannot be an employee/officer/director/contractor with licentiate within last five (5) years of work, if it is more than 2% of their practice. (Bus & Prof. Code § 450)
- Senate Rules Committee: One (1) public member. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)
- Speaker of the Assembly: One (1) public member. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)
- Term: Four (4) years, expiring on June 30. (Bus. & Prof Code § 5515.)
- Appointments expire on June 30 of the fourth year following the year in which the previous term expired. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)

## CALIFORNIA ARCHITECTS BOARD

### (continued)

Term: Vacancies occurring prior to the expiration of the term shall be filled  
(continued) by appointment for the unexpired term. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)

**AB 1822 (2012)**, appointments by the Governor shall have staggered terms whose terms commence on specific dates by requiring certain of those members to serve five (5) and six (6) year terms, as specified.

Of the three (3) licensed members whose terms commence on July 1, 2013, two (2) shall expire on June 30, 2017 and one (1) shall expire on June 30, 2019. The other two (2) licensed members whose terms commence on July 1, 2014, one (1) shall expire on June 30, 2018 and one (1) shall expire on June 30, 2020.

The one (1) public member whose term commences on July 1, 2014, shall expire on June 30, 2019. Of the other two (2) public members whose terms commence on July 1, 2016, one (1) shall expire on June 30, 2020 and one (1) shall expire on June 30, 2021.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.5.)

Term Limit: No person shall serve as a member of the board for more than two consecutive terms. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5515.)

Grace Period: Until the appointment and qualification of his/her successor or until one (1) year since the expiration of the term, whichever first occurs.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 105.5.)

Compensation: One hundred dollars (\$100) per diem and all necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of official duties.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 103.)

Meetings  
Frequency: Shall meet at least once (1) every calendar quarter, and may hold meetings at such other times and places as it may designate.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5522.)

Special meetings shall be called by the executive officer upon written notice of four (4) members by giving each member of the board ten (10) days' written notice of the time and place of the meeting. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5523.)

Bond: No statutory requirement.

Oath: Government Code §§ 1360 – 1363.

Duties:

The board shall delineate the minimum professional qualifications and performance standards for admission to and practice of the profession of architecture. The board shall establish a fair and uniform enforcement policy to deter and prosecute violations of this chapter of any rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this chapter to provide for the protection of the consumer.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5510.1.)

It may also fix the compensation to be paid for such services and incur such additional expense as may be deemed necessary.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5525.)

The board shall adopt rules and regulations governing the examination of applicants for licenses to practice architecture in this state. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5526(a).)

The board may, by rule or regulation, adopt rules of professional conduct that are not inconsistent with state or federal law. Every person who holds a license issued by the board shall be governed and controlled by these rules. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5526(b).)

The board may, from time to time, repeal, amend, or modify rules and regulations adopted under this section. No rule or regulation shall be inconsistent with this chapter.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 5526(d).)

The board shall meet at least once each calendar quarter for the purpose of transacting such business as may lawfully come before it. The board may hold meetings at such other times and at such places as it may designate. (Bus. & Prof. Code § 5522.)

Purpose: Encourage public participation in the arts, help build strong arts organizations, assist with the professional development of arts leaders, promote awareness of the value of arts, and directly fund arts programs in California's communities.

Authority: Government Code § 8751 et seq.

Appointing Power: Governor – 9 (requires Senate confirmation)  
Senate Rules Committee - 1  
Speaker of the Assembly - 1

Number: Eleven (11)

Special Considerations:

Qualifications: When making appointments, the Governor shall request and consider recommendations from organizations representing the arts community and shall give consideration to the various arts disciplines and ethnic and geographic parts of the state.  
(Gov. Code § 8751(a).)

The Senate Rules Committee and the Speaker of the Assembly each appoint one (1) member to represent the general public.  
(Gov. Code § 8751(a).)

Term: Four (4) years, staggered. (Gov. Code § 8751(b).)

Term Limits: Nothing in this section shall prevent the reappointment or replacement of any individual presently serving on the existing Arts Council unless such person has already served for more than four (4) consecutive years as a member. (Gov. Code § 8751(c).)

Grace Period: Sixty (60) days. (Gov. Code § 1774.)

Compensation: One hundred dollars (\$100) per meeting, and necessary traveling and other expenses incurred in performance of official duties.  
(Gov. Code § 8751(d).)

Meeting Frequency: Shall meet at the call of the chair no more than eight (8) times each calendar year. Unless there are extraordinary circumstances, all meetings are to be preceded by at least eight (8) days public notice, and shall be held in various places throughout the state so as to encourage broad and diverse attendance.

Promote the employment of artists and those skilled in crafts in both the public and private sector. (Gov. Code § 8753(c).)

Provide for the exhibition of art works in public buildings throughout California. (Gov. Code § 8753(d).)

Enlist the aid of all state agencies in the task of ensuring the fullest expression of our artistic potential. (Gov. Code § 8753(e).)

Adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act necessary for proper execution of the powers and duties granted to the council by this chapter.  
(Gov. Code § 8753(f).)

Employ such administrative, technical, and other personnel as may be necessary. (Gov. Code § 8753(g).)

Accept federal grants, for any of the purposes of this chapter.  
(Gov. Code § 8753(l).)

Accept only unrestricted gifts, donations, bequests, or grants of funds from private sources and public agencies, for any of the purposes of this chapter. However, the council shall give careful consideration to any donor requests concerning specific dispositions. (Gov. Code § 8753(m).)

Establish grant application criteria and procedure.  
(Gov. Code § 8753(n).)

Award prizes or direct grants to individuals or organizations in accordance with such regulations as the council may prescribe. In awarding prizes or directing grants, the council shall notify the offices of the legislators in whose district the recipient resides.  
(Gov. Code § 8753(o).)

Special Considerations: The members of the commission shall be individuals with knowledge or expertise of the Asian Pacific Islander American Community, whether by experience in training, and who are representative of the community in the state, both geographically and demographically. (Gov. Code § 8256(b)(1).)

Qualifications: Senate Committee on Rules and Speaker of the Assembly shall each make one (1) appointment from a pool of three (3) nominees selected for each of the respective positions by the Asian and Pacific Islander Legislative Caucus. (Gov. Code § 8256(b)(3).)

Term: Four (4) years. (Gov. Code § 8256(b)(5)(A).

Any vacancy in the membership of the commission shall not affect the powers of the commission and shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. (Gov. Code § 8256(b)(6).)

Grace Period: Continues to serve until replacement has qualified. (Gov. Code, § 1302.)

Compensation: None; only actual and necessary travel expenses. (Gov. Code § 8256.5(c).)

- Appointing Power: Governor – 5 (requires Senate confirmation)  
Senate Rules Committee – 1  
Speaker of the Assembly – 1
- Number: Seven (7)
- Special Considerations: No person who is currently licensed, or who was licensed within the last two (2) years, under this chapter may be appointed or reappointed to, or serve on, the commission.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 18602.)
- Qualifications: The Governor, the Senate Rules Committee, and the Speaker of the Assembly shall make every effort to ensure that at least four (4) of the members of the commission shall have experience and demonstrate expertise in one (1) of the following areas:  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 18602(b)(1-4).)
- 1) A licensed physician or surgeon having expertise or specializing in neurology, neurosurgery, head trauma, or sports medicine. Sports medicine includes, but is not limited to, physiology, kinesiology, or other aspects of sports medicine;
  - 2) Financial management;
  - 3) Public Safety;
  - 4) Past experience in the activity regulated by this chapter, either as a contestant, a referee or official, a promoter, or a venue operator.
- Term: Four (4) years. All terms shall end on January 1. Vacancies occurring prior to the expiration of the term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 18602(c).)
- Term Limits: Cannot serve for more than two (2) consecutive full terms.  
(Bus. & Prof. Code § 131.)
- Grace Period: Sixty (60) days (Gov. Code § 1774.)
